I have received several questions/comments about Sunday's sermon, and one question that keeps coming up is regarding the Prayer of Examen. Actually this "concept" is nothing new and is attributed to St. Ignatius Loyola. Below is an excerpt from Sunday's sermon:

"In his wonderful book titled *Prayer: Finding the Heart's True Home*, Richard Foster writes about the so-called Prayer of Examen,

'How very strange, that the Prayer of Examen has been lost to we who live in an age of obsessive introspection...what a loss! What is the Prayer of Examen? It has two basic aspects, like the two sides of a door. The first is the examen of consciousness through which we discover how God has been present to us throughout the day and how we have responded to his loving presence. The second aspect is an examen of conscience in which we uncover those areas that need cleansing, purifying and healing.'"

Examining our conscience every day to identify what needs cleansing, purifying, and healing are crucial to the health of our connectedness to God. A failure to engage in this internal examination will inevitably and unavoidably result in things coming between us and God."

My prayer is that we will all seek God daily!

Driver Orientation Day February 18

The Transportation Committee will hold a driver orientation day on Saturday, February 18, from 9:00 - 11:00 a.m. The purpose of this orientation is to acquaint <u>all</u> drivers of church-owned vehicles with the particular needs associated with multi-passenger vehicles, such as brakes, towing, etc. The church approved a new Transportation Policy at the business conference in January which changes the requirements for driving church vehicles.

All drivers of church-owned buses or vans are strongly requested to come to this session. If weather does not permit on the 18th, the training will be held on the following Saturday, February 25.

Driver Applications Needed

A new Transportation Manual was approved at the January business conference. One of the provisions in this manual states the requirement that anyone who wishes to drive church-owned vehicles must contact the church office and complete a Driver Application form before reservations can be made to use church vehicles. If you are planning an activity which would require transportation provided by the church, contact the church office now and complete your application. The Transportation Committee will approve all drivers, and a driver list will be maintained in the office.
