As Easter people we acknowledge Christ's victory over sin and death, but many times we fail to claim these victories ourselves. Instead we continue to lead defeated lives, settling for a mundane existence that few not-yet believers would desire for themselves. We fight and struggle among ourselves, failing to forgive each other and ourselves.

For the last three weeks, in our LIFE service, we have been talking about: Accepting God's forgiveness; 2) Forgiving one another; and 3) Forgiving ourselves. 
