# A NOTE FROM MARY

#### ...every skilled person to whom the Lord has given skill and ability to know how to carry out all the work of constructing the sanctuary are to do the work just as the Lord commanded –Exodus 36:1

I get a little excited when I read about the construction of the tabernacle. As the construction takes place, it is pointed out that God gave the skills and talents necessary to build the tabernacle. He had skilled woodworkers, metalworkers, workers of fabric, and even musicians to play later in the completed sanctuary. The community was full of artists who were busy doing their work each day, but who were given the opportunity to use their skills for the glory of God.

God has also gifted College Park with artists, musicians, and skilled workers. We see examples of that as skills are used in ministry in Kentucky and our community. **I want to share with you another opportunity to share the artistic talents God has placed in our midst**. In conjunction with our 60th Anniversary activities this October, we are going to have an art exhibition. I know that we have painters,

I hesitate to give too much direction for fear of limiting or telling you what to create; however, I am praying that God will speak to those among you who are artists (and may not even consider yourselves as such) to inspire you to share those gifts to the glory of God as we celebrate His love and the community of believers from which He has called us to love and serve. More information on this opportunity is coming. I ask you to pray as to whether God might want you to share your talents in this way.
