A NOTE FROM MARY



I had an interesting moment this morning as I began to teach a small group for Fearless. I looked at my group and saw three strong women, three very strong women, the kind of women you look at and think, "Man, they can do anything they set their minds to do." I immediately had to go off the book and admit to them that they did not strike me as the type to deal with fear a lot. And I had to question why I made that assumption. I also had to admit that sometimes I do make the assumption that people are doing okay when they aren't. I've had another conversation recently in which I expressed the reality that often we look at others in the church and have no idea of what they are dealing with outside of the walls of the church. We see strong Christian sisters and brothers, leaders, who are hurting, yet we are unaware because the needs aren't shared publicly and, again, the assumption is made that everything is okay. It reminded me of an anthem that has been sitting on my desk for a while (which will need to be sung soon).

It says:

Pray for the person on your left.
Pray for the person on your right.
They may seem strong,
but we don't know all of the struggles and the
burdens they hold. We pray, Lord we pray.
Give them power to face the day.
They try to be strong, but only You know
all of the struggles and the burdens they hold.
We pray, Lord, we pray,
Give them power to face the day.

I know that sometimes the Spirit leads us to pray for people and we don't even know why. If this article has brought someone to mind, I challenge you to pray and to let them know that God placed them on your heart. They may need to hear that you (and God!) love them.




Baptists know how to party!
