While I cannot say I necessarily agree with every conclusion of each author (when such conclusions are drawn outside of scripture), these books are interesting reading and perhaps will answer more questions than they prompt: 90 Minutes in Heaven by Don Piper; One Minute After You Die by Erwin Lutzer; Things You Don't Know about Heaven by Judson Cornwall; and Heaven by Randy Alcorn.

Then next Sunday, March 7th, we will look at the "Fear of Global Calamity," which is kinda' related to the fear of death and the unknown, so some of the principles will translate well. Again, remember God told us repeatedly in His Word to "Fear Not"...come worship with JOY!!!


Baptists know how to party!
