

Summer Mission Committee

The Summer Mission Committee has been working on an alternate location for our traditional Mountain Outreach building project. It has been a source of joy to College Park members to provide a complete home for a needy family every year. We are happy to report that we have a new location to do this exciting service.

The committee has made several trips to Grifton Mission Ministry in Pitt County, NC. After Hurricane Floyd, College Park assisted with repairs to 13 homes in this area. It is the recommendation of this committee that we travel to the Greenville area (about 3 hours away) and build a home for a needy family. The coordinator of Grifton Mission Ministries, Billy Tarlton, will work with Pitt County officials to select the family. There will likely be some building funds available to help with the cost of construction. We anticipate the cost to College Park to be comparable to previous years.

There will be information presented on Wednesday, March 2 and 16. The committee will be available to answer questions on Sunday, March 13 between 10:30 and 11:00 and 12:00 and 12:30. The church will vote on Sunday, March 20.

There will be a called church conference on Sunday, March 20, during both morning services to vote on this recommendation from the Summer Mission Committee. The recommendation is to build a home in Pitt County on July 2 - 8, 2011.
