

#### An Update from the Facility Update Committee...

Many of us agree that 2011 was a year of great blessings throughout our church. One of these blessings has been the completion of the education building renovation project. God's guiding hand was evident throughout that process. Our committee is thankful for the many people who made this phase of our current construction project so successful. We give glory to God for His faithfulness and providence.



As we celebrate what God has done in the completed renovation of the education building, the church is also looking to begin the construction of the approved gymnasium and Smith Hall renovations. We are actively working on this process. In addition to this work, our committee has become aware of additional construction/renovation needs throughout the church. This includes the longdiscussed connector between the sanctuary and chapel as well as additional renovations deemed necessary due to the recent space swap between the Adult 4 and Youth Departments.

It is our intention to bring both the approved projects and these new projects into one proposal during a called church conference in late February (please note this change from last month's article). The regularly scheduled business conference on January 18 will serve as the first of several information sessions when church members can ask questions. Several more sessions will be held in the weeks leading up to the called conference. A schedule of all the important dates will be mailed to each home and publicized widely over the coming weeks. During the called conference, the church will vote on how to move forward given all the information secured by the appropriate committees including a recommendation on funding.

Our committee looks forward to 2012 with great anticipation in regards to these construction projects and ministry opportunities. We ask for your prayers as we play our part in building God's kingdom here at College Park!
