

### From Your Pastorm



## FACILITY UPDATE PROCESS

#### GOOD NEWS!

We are pleased to announce that we are financing our gym and additional church-approved projects with our very own bank,



BB&T. They aggressively sought to be our lender for this project in order to maintain our relationship. BB&T has waived loan origination fees, offered \$1,500 toward closing costs and given us a 4.14% rate on a 20-year amortization with a 10-year balloon. This is a true blessing for our church to get great terms with this reputable bank. Our Finance Committee is pleased. The payment will be an estimated \$12,652 per month. Please get your contributions in for this project as early as you can. We will pay additional principal each month if we are able to do so with your generous contributions. This will decrease the amount of interest we pay in the long run! We would love to have this loan knocked out in 10 years. Thank you for your sacrifice in making this happen!

Before construction can begin, there are many things happening in the background. We are finalizing drawings, negotiating contracts, and fine tuning many details between the contractor and the bank. It is similar to getting a loan on your own residence and going through the closing process. We have to get an appraisal, government record search, secure insurance, and possibly have a church site survey. Then we have lots of paperwork to sign. We are quickly trying to take care of these things so that we could possibly see shovels hit the ground in early July. Stay tuned for further updates!

I hope you are aware that in our most recent quarterly business conference the church called Melissa Keltner as the Family Ministry Intern with Youth for this summer. At that time there was not a candidate for the Family Ministry Intern with Children. Since the conference, members of the preschool and children's ministry councils met, interviewed, and voted to recommend the hiring of Meghan Wham, a junior education major at Queens College and Pfafftown resident. The Personnel Committee voted to approve this hire. Both intern positions have been budgeted for in the 2012 Ministry Action Plan. During the called business meeting on June 3, 2012, the Family Ministry Team and the Personnel Committee will also ask the Church to affirm the hiring of both of our interns. This will be a great opportunity to meet and encourage them!
