

*The Walk* by Richard Paul Evans– The first in a series of books-After losing his wife, Alan Christoffersen decides to walk from Seattle to Key West on a search for hope.

*False Witness* by Randy Singer– A bail bondsman's wife is kidnapped. He has 48 hours to find an Indian professor in possession of an equation that could break all internet encryption. Part action, part legal thriller, this book has a lot of twists and turns.

The Vow by Kim & Krickitt Carpenter– A true story and basis for a movie by the same name, Kim and Krickitt Carpenter fell in love and were married only to have those marriage vows challenged by a horrible accident. Just weeks after the wedding, Krickett awoke from a coma with no memory of her husband. This is the story of how their faith in Christ helped them to fall in love all over again.

Lying Awake by Mark Salzman-Sister John is a Carmelite nun who has been blessed for years by special visions from God which inspire her poetry that has been recognized at the highest levels of the Catholic church. When she finds out that her visions are caused by a serious medical condition, she must make a choice and contemplate her faith and her calling.
