# From Your Pastorna

It's hard to believe, but *Re:Creation* will be three years old this Sunday! That's right...we began this "new" service on the first Sunday of February 2010, "Super Sunday"...for several reasons! As this service has evolved, we have seen many families join our fellowship and many people come to know Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior! What a blessing it is to be part of a church that continues to explore new ways to express the timeless message of Jesus Christ!

As we worship together, one of the most meaningful times in the church year is the season of Lent. This year Ash Wednesday is on February 13, so our journey to the cross begins officially on that day. Unofficially, the journey will actually begin on the Sunday prior to Ash Wednesday (February 10) as we begin a special Lenten emphasis entitled "The Way." This emphasis will lead us through the Lenten season, exploring the ministry of Jesus as we see video and hear stories of his life and journey. The worship services

on Sunday, as well as many Sunday School classes and the Wednesday Family Night studies, will focus on this journey. Here's an overview:

Week # 1: **Baptism and Temptation** *Mark 1:9-13; Matthew 4:1-11* 

Week #2: **The Healing Ministry** *Mark 1:21-28; Luke 4:18-19* 

Week #3: **Proclaiming the Kingdom** *Matthew 5:1-2a, 7:24-29* 

Week #4: **Calming the Storm** *Mark 3:35-41* 

Week #5: Sinners, Outcasts, and the **Poor** *John 4:3-10* 

Week #6: **The Final Week**Mark 11:7-10

Week #7: **Epilogue** *John 20:19-23* 

We have a "snow day" factored in, but hopefully we will not need to use it. I know you will be blessed by this study as we journey to the cross together!
