This past Sunday we "unofficially" began our journey to the cross. The reason I say "unofficially" is because Ash Wednesday is the "official" beginning point for our Lenten journey. For many of us, Ash Wednesday is still fairly new since many Baptists churches did not/do not observe Ash Wednesday. For us, it is an incredibly meaningful service as we remember the forty days of fasting and prayer that Jesus used to prepare for his ministry (and to resist the temptations of Satan). May we use this Lenten journey to pray, fast, and encourage each other as we resist the temptations that Satan and this world throw at us, and align our wills to the Father's!

Let me strongly encourage you to be a part of "The Way" small group studies as we journey through Lent. Several Sunday School classes are using this material; but if your class is not, remember we are using it on Wednesday nights also! This series will lead us through the Lenten season, exploring the ministry of Jesus as we see video and hear stories of his life and journey. The worship services on Sunday, as well as many Sunday School classes and the Wednesday Family Night studies will focus on this journey. Here's an overview:
