# NOTE FROM MARY

I had to confess to a group of ladies this morning that I don't have it all figured out, that I, in all my minister-ness, still don't have all the answers. In fact, I struggle with the attitudes that God would have me to live. There are things about God I still don't understand, and there are parts of life and walking with God I don't "get." Settling at my desk I started some music, and this song by Addison Road is the first thing I heard:

I made You promises a thousand times. I've tried to hear from heaven, but I talked the whole time. I think I made You too small. I never feared You at all. If you touched my face would I know You, looked into my eyes could I behold You? What do I know of You who spoke me into motion? Where have I even stood, but the shore along Your ocean? Are You fire? Are You fury? Are You sacred? Are You beautiful? So, what do I know of holy? I guess I thought that I had figured You out. I knew all the stories and I learned to talk about how You were mighty to save. But those were only empty words on a page. Then I caught a glimpse of who You might be. The slightest hint of You brought me down to my knees. What do I know of holy? What do I know of wounds that will heal my shame, and a God who gave life its name?

What do I know of holy, of the One who the angels praise? All creation knows Your name on earth and heaven above, what do I know of this love?

By the end of our discussion this morning, I had to admit I am not sure that I want a God that I can fully understand. But I confess that sometimes the wrestling with how to love and how to live is harder than I'm comfortable admitting.
