## A NOTE FROM MARY



Occasionally, in looking for books for Book Club to read, I run across some that are good reads but don't get chosen for Book Club. The following are a few of those:

The Ringmaster's Wife by Kristy Cambron

Set in the glittering backdrop of the heyday of the Ringling Brothers circus, two women choose to take a chance on the unknown.

The Girl with Seven Names: A North Korean Defector's Story by Hyeonseo Lee

A true story, Hyeonseo Lee shares what it was like to grow up in North Korea in the 1990's and the turn her life took when she innocently crosses the border into China and becomes a defector.

Silence by Shusaku Endo

Written by a Japanese convert to Roman Catholocism, the book tells the story of two 17th century Portuguese priests who travel to Japan. They have heard of the persecution of Christians and of the well-publicized apostasy of a respected priest. The story asks the questions: Why does God seem silent in the midst of suffering? And is it possible to betray your faith but remain true to your God? A thought-provoking read.

The Bachelor Girls Guide to Murder by Rachel McMillan

Just for fun. In 1910 Toronto, while other bachelor girls perfect their domestic skills and find husbands, two friends perfect their sleuthing skills and find a murderer. Navigating the cultural expectations of the day and dodging the morality squad, two women work as a female Sherlock and Holmes.
